Suffield Conservation Commission Fishing Derby Rules

- 1. Have FUN!
- 2. All participants must register before fishing.
- 3. Participants must not turn 17 years of age on or before May 15, 2022.
- 4. All youth must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- 5. The Conservation Commission Fishing Derby officially begins at 9:00AM (No fishing before).
- 6. The Official weigh-in for the derby closes at 11:00AM. If you are not in line by 11:00AM with your fish, it will not be weighed.
- 7. Observe and respect other people around you.
- 8. Alcohol or controlled substances are NOT allowed at this event.
- 9. PLEASE PICK UP ALL TRASH AT THE END OF THE DERBY
- 10. Adults may help kids, if needed. Let the kids fish as much as they can.
- 11. One fishing pole per child.
- 12. All fish caught must be taken to the checkpoint table at the pavilion for official weigh-in. Please weigh-in fish right after they are caught.
- 13. All fish caught will be kept by the anglers (PLEASE NO CATCH AND RELEASE).
- 14. Fish may be caught from shore. Canoes and Kayaks are permitted with proper life vests. NO MOTORIZED crafts will be allowed.
- 15. Those fishing from a canoe or kayak will not cast near those that are fishing from shore.
- 16. Prizes will be awarded at the end of the fishing derby around 11:30AM
- 17. Winners need to be present to claim their awards.
- 18. The biggest fish will be determined by weight.
- 19. All ties will be subject to a random drawing.
- 20. All prizes must be accepted as awarded and have no other surrender value.
- 21. All decisions made by event coordinators are final.
